"We wanted to celebrate Australian design through unique and inimitable colour schemes, materials, fittings and design," Ms Maczyk said.

"This is expressed in gallery-style track lighting in the ceiling, which has great flexibility."

Engineered timber flooring and wool carpets feature in the apartments, along with baths,

basins and tapware from Australian designer Marc Newson for Caroma.

Prices range from \$460,000 to \$655,000 for one-bedroom designs, \$720,000 and \$1.3 million for two-bedroom designs and \$3.3 million to \$6.9 million for three-bedroom designs on levels 18 to 20 and the level 21 penthouse.

Construction is expected to start in October for completion in late 2017.
